

# INFORMATION ABOUT TOEFL TEST SCORES

Three section scale scores and a total scale score are reported for the computer-based TOEFL. The three scaled section scores are for Listening, Structure/Writing, and Reading. The essay rating is part of the Structure/Writing score; it is also reported separately on this form.

On the computer-based test, the total scaled score ranges from 0 to 300\*, with each scaled section score ranging from 0 to 30:
